Myanmar Earthquake Relief Appeal

Dear Regional Directors,

After the devastating earthquake in Myanmar, the committee of Natural Disaster Relief Emergency Fund (NDREF) swiftly responded and had a meeting on March 31, 2025 via Zoom. It was agreed that a USD5,000 NDREF grant will be given for the relief works in Mandalay and other Northern areas executed by Y's Men's Club in Myanmar in collaboration with YMCAs.

However, this USD 5,000 is far from enough for humanitarian relief and restoration efforts. As of today, it was reported that more than 3,000 were dead and many more injured. Also, thousands of people remain homeless and urgently need essential aid.

Standing in solidarity with Y's Men, YMCAs and the people of Myanmar, we, therefore, appeal for your generous donation. Since there is urgency in carrying out relief work, we request that donations be made by May 5, 2025. We hope all clubs and individuals showing their care and love to those affected people, will respond generously to the appeal, no matter small or big amounts., It helps to give hope and a light to victims of the earthquake.
